# - Treasurer Report:

Jamie worked on getting advertisers for the relocation guides, did the Movies in the Park, and mailed out some visitor guides. Things are going well on her side of things. She has someone that will be visiting next meeting to discuss decorating the town like a Hallmark movie not many details at this point.

### - Summer Nights:

Amber said she has everything lined up for the road closure of 2<sup>nd</sup> and Main to the corner. They do not think they need to close 3<sup>rd</sup>, so it will just end at the Longhorn. The battle of the barrels will be in front of the Longhorn and then extend back. The band will be on a 30-35 foot flatbed gooseneck trailer this time. She has a couple trailers arranged incase the one is to small and guys will be bringing those in as needed. She has food vendors lined up. All fired up, Uncle Louie's and the Longhorn will all be serving food. She did have to cancel the chasing of the

Sundance Kid because the Sheriff's department backed out. The money from the canisters around town for the event will be collected and will be determined where it goes at that point.

Everything is lined up and ready to go for the event. The Shop Small part of the event has not had a large amount of participation. Some donations for prizes have come in. Serendipity is donating a basket, the longhorn one carried over, and Bruce will do a print. Bruce said he would recommend that we do a smaller chamber bucks say \$50 instead of the \$100. Other gift cards might come in. Several places did not have anyone so they might not be open for it or will adjust hours for the event. Hopefully more people will participate going forward.
